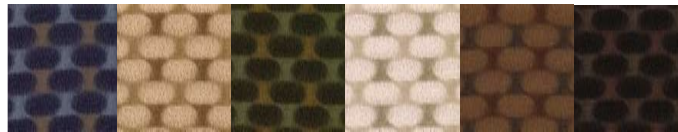

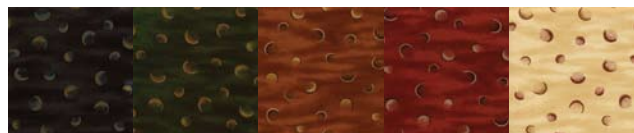

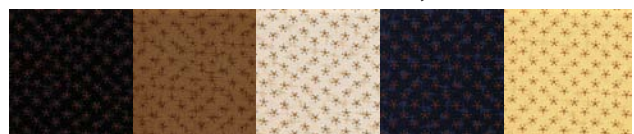

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Let's Begin

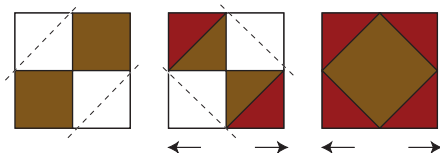
Light and dark stars are a key element in this scrappy star quilt easily made from assorted fat quarters featuring the "Take Me Home" fabric line from *Seattle Bay Fabrics*. Before you begin read all instructions. Sew an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam allowances and use an assembly line method to construct this quilt. Press seams in direction of arrows as indicated in each diagram.

Making the Shadow Star Blocks

Stars are made from nine different fabrics for each of Fabric A, B and C in step instructions match Fabric A pieces when constructing a block.

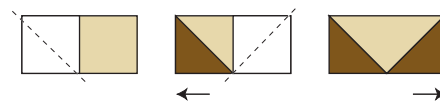
Shadow Star Lap Quilt 53" x 53"		Cuts	
Read all instructions before beginning. Use an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam allowance for this project.			
 Fabric A Background *cut each from nine fabrics	4* 4*	$3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	
 Fabric B Block Center & Star Points *cut each from nine fabrics	1* 8*	$6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	
 Fabric C Block Triangles *cut each from nine fabrics	4*	$3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	
 Fabric D Sashing	3 4 6	$2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 " $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "	
 Fabric E Outside Border	5	$4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 "	
 Fabric F Binding	6	$2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 42 "	

- Steps 1 and 2 are made using the Simple Triangle technique. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares. This will be your sewing line. Place two marked squares on one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square as shown. Stitch on drawn line, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from stitch lines and press. Sew remaining marked square to piece as shown. Trim and press. Make nine, one of each variation.



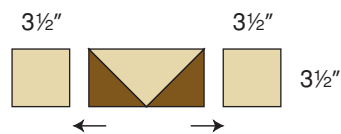
Fabric C- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square
Fabric B- $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square
Make 9 (one of each variation)

- Making simple triangles units, sew two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares to one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A piece. Press. Make thirty-six, four of each variation.



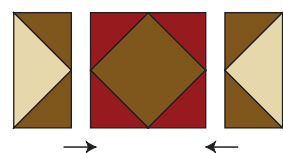
Fabric B- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square
Fabric A- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
Make 36 (four of each variation)

- Sew one unit from step 2 between two matching $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares as shown. Press. Make eighteen, two of each variation.



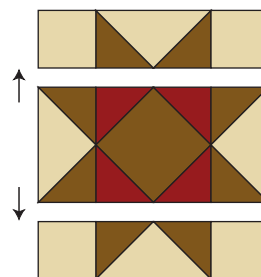
Make 18 (two of each variation)

- Sew one unit from step 1 between two matching units from step 2 as shown. Press. Make nine, one of each variation.



Make 9 (one of each variation)

- Sew one unit from step 4 between two matching units from step 3 as shown. Press. Make nine, one of each variation. Shadow Star Block measures $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Assembly

- Referring to photo and layout, sew together three Shadow Star blocks and two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strips. Press. Make three.

- Referring to photo and layout, arrange and sew four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strips and rows from step 1. Press.

- Sew three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 " Fabric D strips end-to-end to make one continuous $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strip. Measure quilt through center from top to bottom and cut two strips to this measurements. Sew to sides of quilt. Press.

- Sew $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 " Fabric E strips end-to-end to make one continuous $4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide Fabric E strip. Press. Measure quilt from side to side. Cut two $4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips to this measurement. Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward border.

- Measure quilt through center from top to bottom, including borders just added. Cut two $4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide Fabric E strips to this measurement. Sew to sides of quilt and press.

- Cut backing into two equal pieces. Sew pieces together to make one 58 " x 80 " approximate backing piece. Press and trim to 58 " x 58 " backing piece.

- Press backing and quilt top trimming all excess threads. Layer and baste backing, batting and quilt top together. Hand or machine quilt and bind as desired.
