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Getting Started

This quilt features the Nobu Fujiyama Collection - Chou Chou Group presented by Kona Bay Fabrics. Before you begin, read all instructions. Sew an accurate ¼"-wide seam allowance and use an assembly line method to construct this quilt. Press seams in direction of arrows as indicated in each diagram.

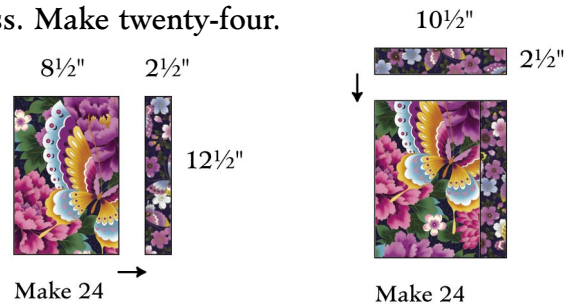
Assembly Line Method

Use this method when making multiple pieces or blocks.

1. Position pieces right sides together, stitch unit.
2. Align and sew the next unit without breaking threads, continue this process to stitch additional units. Cut sections apart, press and continue with next step.

Making the Weave Block

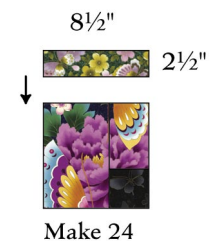
1. Sew one 2½" x 12½" Fabric B piece to one 8½" x 12½" Fabric A piece. Press. Make twenty-four. Sew one 2½" x 10½" Fabric B piece to unit as shown. Press. Make twenty-four.



2. Sew one 3½" x 5½" Fabric A piece to one 3½" Fabric C square. Press. Make twenty-four. Sew one 8½" x 5½" Fabric A piece to unit as shown. Press. Make twenty-four.



3. Sew one 2½" x 8½" Fabric D piece to one unit from step 2. Press. Make twenty-four.



4. Sew one 2½" x 10½" Fabric D piece to one unit from step 3. Press. Make twenty-four.



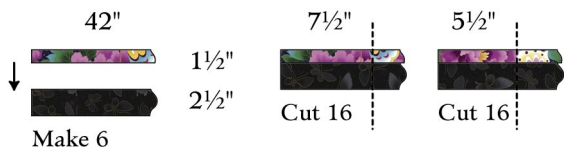
5. Sew one unit from step 1 to one unit from step 4 as shown. Press. Make twenty-four. Weave Block measures 10½" x 24½".

Making the Blossom Block

1. Sew together one 1½" x 42" Fabric A strip to one 2½" x 42" Fabric C strip as shown to make a strip set. Press. Make five. Cut sixteen 7½" segments and sixteen 5½" segments from strip set as shown.



2. Rotate 7½" strip unit from step 1 as shown. Sew one unit to one 5½" x 7½" Fabric A piece. Press. Make sixteen.



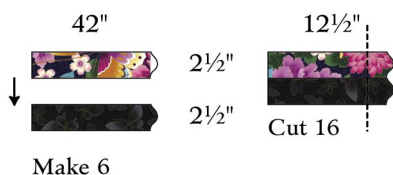
3. Sew one 5½" strip unit from step 1 to one 3½" Fabric D square. Press. Make sixteen.



4. Sew one unit from step 2 between one 2½" x 8½" Fabric C piece and one unit from step 3. Press. Make sixteen.



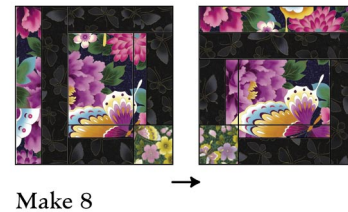
5. Arrange and sew together one 2½" x 42" Fabric A strip to one 2½" x 42" Fabric C strip as shown to make a strip set. Press. Make five. Cut sixteen 12½" segments from strip set as shown.



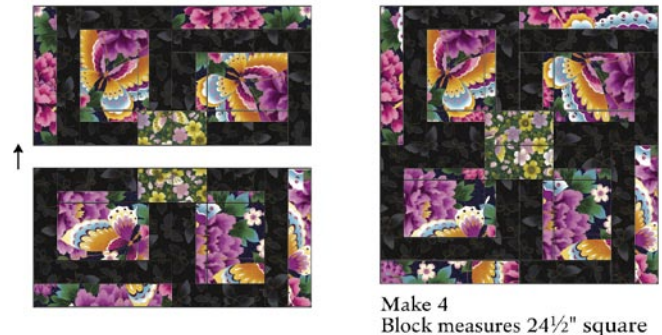
6. Rotate unit from step 5 as shown. Sew one strip unit to one unit from step 4. Press. Make sixteen. Block measures 12½" square.



7. Rotate units from step 6 as shown. Sew two units together in pairs. Press. Make eight.



8. Rotate units from step 7 as shown. Press. Sew two units together as shown. Make four. Block measures 24½" square.



Assembly

1. Referring to quilt layout, arrange and sew four Weave Blocks end-to-end in vertical row. Press. Make six, press seams in opposite direction from row to row.

2. Referring to quilt layout, arrange and rotate every other row, sewing five rows across to make the body of the quilt. Press seams in opposite directions from row to row. Set one Weave Row aside.

3. Referring to quilt layout, arrange, rotate and sew four Blossom Blocks from step 8 in a vertical row. Press.

4. Sew 2½" Sashing A strips end-to-end to make one continuous 2½"-wide sashing strip. Measure Blossom Row from top to bottom. Cut two 2½"-wide Sashing A strips to this measurement.

5. Referring to quilt layout, arrange and sew Blossom Row between two Sashing A strips. Referring to quilt layout, sew between five row Weave Panel and Weave single row, noting orientation of rows. Press.

6. Sew 2½" Sashing B strips end-to-end to make one continuous 2½"-wide sashing strip. Measure quilt from top to bottom. Cut two 2½"-wide Sashing B strips to this measurement and add to sides of quilt. Press.

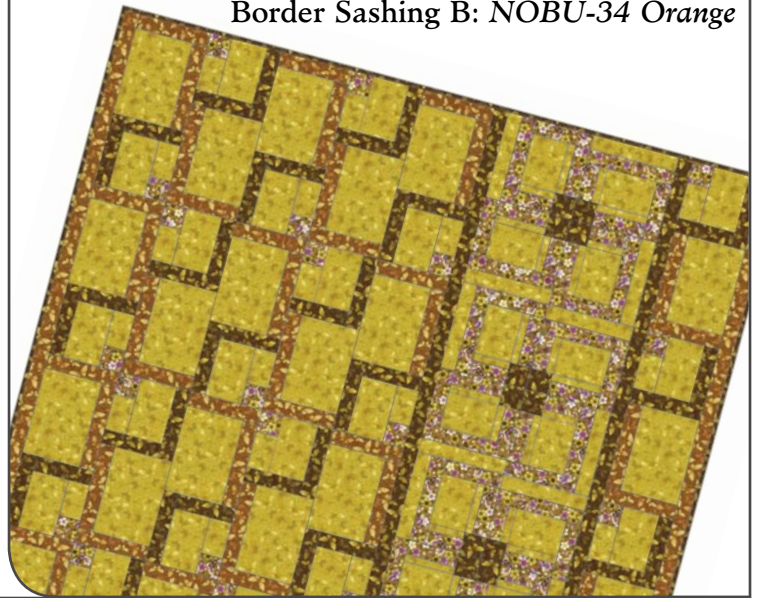
Finishing the Quilt

1. Cut backing crosswise in two equal pieces and sew together. Press backing and quilt top trimming all excess threads. Layer and baste backing, batting and quilt top together. Hand or machine quilt and bind as desired.
