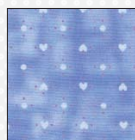

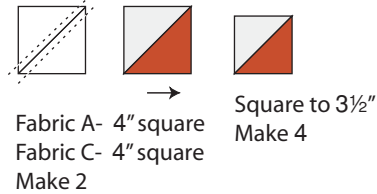
Let's Begin

This quilt features the "Take Me Home" fabric line presented by Seattle Bay Fabrics. Before you begin read all instructions. Sew an accurate 1/4"-wide seam allowances and use an assembly line method to construct this quilt. Press seams in direction of arrows as indicated in each diagram.

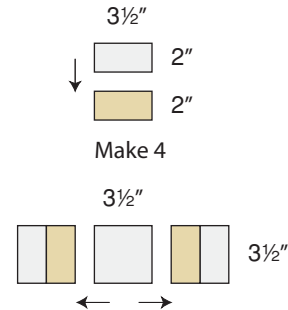
Shoofly Lullaby Quilt 40" x 58"		Cuts
Read all instructions before beginning use an accurate 1/4"-wide seam allowance for this project.		
 Fabric A Background	16 8 32	4" squares 3 1/2" squares 3 1/2" x 2"
 Fabric B Block Accents, Border & Binding	5 4 1 4	6 1/2" x 42" 4" squares 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" squares
 Fabric C Block & Border Accents	4 1 4	4" squares 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" squares
 Fabric D Block & Border Accents	4 2 4	4" squares 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" squares
 Fabric E Block & Border Accents	4 1 4	4" squares 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" squares
 Fabric F Block Accents	3 4	3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" x 2"
 Fabric G Block Accents	3 8	3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" x 2"
 Fabric H Block Accents	3 4	3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" x 2"
 Fabric I Block Accents	2 8	3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" x 2"
 Fabric J Block Accents	3 8	3 1/2" x 9 1/2" 3 1/2" x 2"
 Fabric K Block Accents	2	3 1/2" x 9 1/2"

Making the Shoofly Block

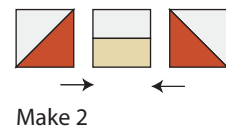
1. Make Half-Square Triangles by drawing a diagonal line on the wrong side of one 4" Fabric A square. Place marked square and one 4" Fabric C square right side together. Sew a scant 1/4" away from drawn line on both sides, cut on drawn line, and press. Make two. Trim squares to 3 1/2" to make four half-square triangle units.



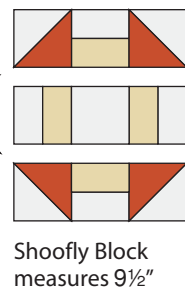
2. Sew one 3 1/2" x 2" Fabric A piece to one 3 1/2" x 2" Fabric H piece as shown. Make four. Sew one 3 1/2" Fabric A square between two of these units. Press.



3. Sew one unit from step 2 between two units from step 1 as shown. Press. Make two.



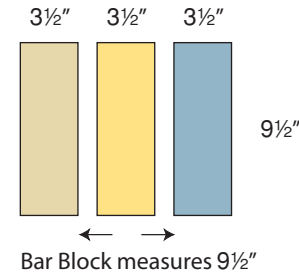
4. Sew one unit from step 2 between two units from step 3 checking orientation of units prior to sewing. Press. Shoofly Block measures 9 1/2" square.



5. Referring to steps 1-4 make a total of eight Shoofly Blocks, one each using the following fabric combinations; A/D/I, A/B/G, A/E/J, A/E/G, A/C/J, A/B/I, and A/D/F.

Making the Bar Block

1. Sew one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric E strip between one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric H strip and one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric G strip as shown. Press. Bar Block measures 9 1/2" square.

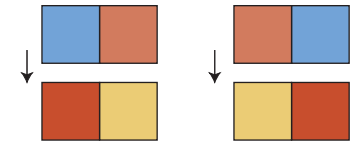


2. Refer to step 1 to make a total of seven blocks using the following combination of fabrics, F/K/J, H/C/J, G/D/I, H/D/I, F/B/G, and F/K/J.

Assembly

- Referring to photo and layout, sew one Bar Block between two Shoofly Blocks. Press. Make three. Press toward Bar Block.
- Sew one Shoofly Block between two Bar Blocks. Press toward Bar Block. Make two.
- Referring to photo and layout arrange and sew together rows from steps 1 and 2.
- Sew five 6 1/2" x 42" Fabric B strips end-to-end to make one continuous 6 1/2"-wide strip. Measure quilt through center from top to bottom and side-to-side and cut two strips to each of these measurements. Sew short strips to top and bottom of quilt. Press.
- Sew one 3 1/2" Fabric B square to one 3 1/2" Fabric D square. Press toward Fabric B. Sew one 3 1/2" Fabric C square to one 3 1/2" Fabric E

square. Press toward Fabric E. Sew these units together as shown. Press. Make four, two of each combination.



Make 4
(two of each variation)

- Sew one long strip from step 4 between two units from step 5, one of each combination. Press. Make two and sew to sides of quilt.
- Cut backing into two equal pieces. Sew pieces together to make one 47" x 80" approximate backing piece.
- Press backing and quilt top trimming all excess threads. Layer and baste backing, batting and quilt top together. Hand or machine quilt and bind as desired.
